Rosanne Altshuler is a senior fellow at the Urban Institute and the director of the Urban-Brookings Tax Policy Center. She is a former professor of economics at Rutgers University. Altshuler served as the senior economist on the President's Advisory Panel on Federal Tax Reform in 2005 and was a special adviser to the Joint Committee on Taxation and consultant to the U.S. Treasury Department and Canadian Department of Finance. She edited the *National Tax Journal* from 2001 through 2006.

Ted Gayer is the codirector of economic studies and Joseph A. Pechman Senior Fellow at the Brookings Institution, where he conducts research on public finance, environmental and energy economics, housing, and regulatory policy. Gayer was formerly associate professor of public policy at Georgetown University, deputy assistant secretary for economic policy at the Department of the Treasury, and senior economist at the President's Council of Economic Advisers.
